New Features in this Release

Control Rocket at the User Group Level

Prior to the 2017.7 release, to utilize the Rocket interface, a user had to:

- Belong to a **User Group** that had the 'HTML Experience' privilege enabled
- Enable the 'Use the new HTML user interface' **user property** in 'Preferences'
- Log out and log back in

After the 2017.7 release, the Rocket interface will be the default view for any user who is in a **User Group** that has the 'HTML Experience' privilege enabled. In other words, users will not have the 'Preference' to toggle Rocket experience on or off.

This is to aid our customers in their ability to control the rollout to their end users, without requiring action by the end users themselves.

To ensure a continuous experience for all users that have previously enabled the Rocket interface, the 2017.7 release will programmatically add all these to a new 'Rocket' User Group. No administrative action is required to facilitate this process.

Range Tag and Multiple Tag Support in DirectURL

Range tags are now supported in a DirectURL. This means you can add a range tag using the following syntax:

Previously existing syntax for searching on a normal tag:

• tagname=AssemblyNumber&tagvalue=123

New syntax for searching on range tags

- tagname=Serial Number&tagvalue=123&tagvaluePrefix=ABC
- tagname=Serial Number&tagvalue=123&tagvalueSuffix=DEF

New syntax for searching using multiple tag values:

tagname0=Serial
 Number&tagvalue0=123&tagvaluePrefix0=APP&tagname1=Assembly&tagvalue1=2233
 (mutliple tags)
